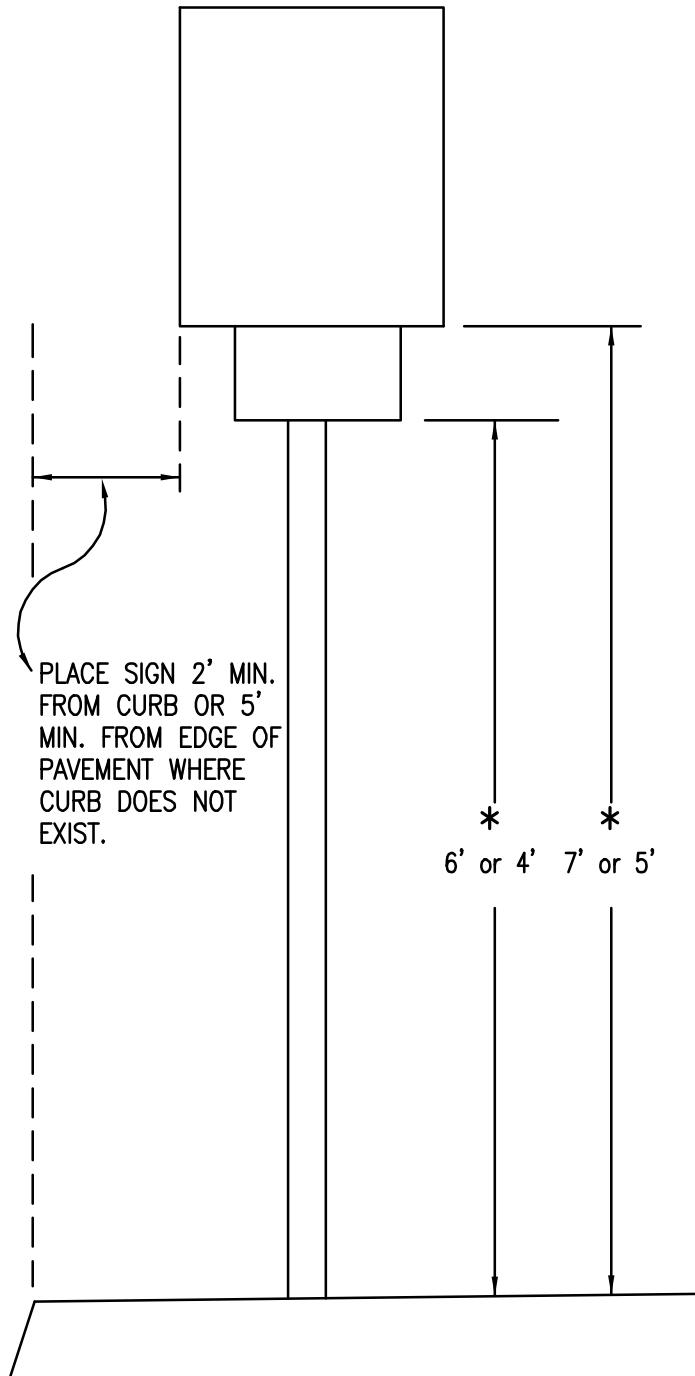


NONE: POST INSTALLATION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD DRAWING NO. 301

* SIGNS HEIGHTS
 Warning Signs
 (CALTRANS 4-01.23)
 shall be mounted at a height of at least 5 feet, measured from the bottom of the sign to the near edge of the pavement. In business, commercial and residential areas where parking and/or pedestrian movement is likely to occur or where there are other obstructions to view, the clearance to the bottom of the sign shall be at least 7 feet. The height to the bottom of a secondary sign mounted below another sign may be 1 foot less than the appropriate height specified above.

Regulatory Sign
 (CALTRANS 4.03.2)
 The bottom of the sign shall be 5 feet above the surface of the pavement on conventional highways. In urban areas and where parking is prevalent, the bottom of the sign shall be placed at least 7 feet above the top of the curb.
